

One Skein Plush Keyhole Scarf

This is a super soft and cozy scarf that makes a great gift because it can be knit in only a few hours. And since it only takes one ball of yarn, it is quite economical as well.

Materials needed:

- Berroco Plush – 1 ball (90yds)
- Size 10 (6mm) circular or straights
- Tapestry needle

Dimensions: 4.5” x 40”

Gauge: 15 stitches per 4” in garter stitch
(exact gauge is not critical)



Cast on 17 stitches.

Knit every row (garter stitch) for approximately 10 inches.

Next row: knit first 5 stitches, bind off 7 stitches, knit remaining 5 stitches.

Next row: knit 5 stitches, cast on 7 stitches, knit remaining 5 stitches.

Knit every row (garter stitch) until you have about 1.5 feet of yarn remaining. Bind off and weave in ends.
